Approval of building component that comes into contact with drinking water – Limescale preventer Dropson EMI

The Secretariat for building components approved for drinking water has received your payment of the approval fee for the application of 19 February 2014 on approval of **Limescale preventer Dropson EMI** as a building component that comes into contact with drinking water.

Approval number and validity

The Secretariat hereby issue the approval of **Limescale preventer Dropson EMI** as a building component that comes into contact with drinking water, cf. section 4 (2) of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013 on issue of approvals for building components that come into contact with drinking water, as amended by Executive Order No. 1259 of 5 November 2013.

We enclose the certificate for the approval with approval No. 05/00001.

The approval is valid from 11 April 2014 and is valid for a period of three years up until and including 10 April 2017, cf. section 18 (1) of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013.

Conditions of approval

The terms and conditions of approval are stipulated in Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013 on issue of approvals for building components that come into contact with drinking water, as amended by Executive Order No. 1259 of 5 November 2013, and the Danish Energy Agency's Guidance Statement of 6 November 2013 on agreements on annual inspection, cf. section 12 (1) of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013.

Basis of approval

The approval is issued on the basis of the following documentation:

- List of versions of Limescale preventer Dropson EMI
- Photo and drawings of Limescale preventer Dropson EMI
- Agreement on annual inspection
- Solemn declaration on the establishment of an own-control programme
- Further information submitted by e-mails of 3 and 14 March 2014

Description and technical data

The approval covers the versions of the building components that are specified in the list of product names which, together with the certificate, is published on the website of the secretariat of approval: <http://english.godkendtildrikkevand.dk/>.

The approved building component is made of: stainless steel alloys 1.4404/EN10027 and 1.4307/EN10027.

The building product cannot be manufactured in “on demand” production.

Manufacturer and manufacturing site(s)

It is stated in the application that the building component is manufactured by Hierrodifusion SL at the following manufacturing site(s):

- C/ Pintores No 52 Poligono Industrial Ind II, 03130 Santa Pola, Spain

Acceptance of the conditions of approval

You have paid an approval fee pursuant to section 22 of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013 on issue of approvals for building components that come into contact with drinking water and Executive Order No. 32 of 21 January 2013 on payment for the processing of applications for approval of building components that come into contact with drinking water.

By paying the approval fee, you have accepted the conditions of maintaining the approval during the entire approval period, cf. Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013 on issue of approvals for building components that come into contact with drinking water, as amended by Executive Order No. 1259 of 5 November 2013. The payment equates with entering an agreement on certification in accordance with section 19 (1) of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013.

Guidance on meeting the conditions of approval

As the approval holder it is your responsibility to meet the conditions of approval during the entire approval period. Therefore, please be aware of the following main points in order to meet the conditions of approval:

You must establish and maintain an own-control programme, including reception control and final product control for the building component approved, to ensure that you meet the conditions of approval during the entire approval period, cf. section 10 (1) (2nd sentence) and section 11 of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013.

In connection with the agreement on the annual inspection, cf. section 13 of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013, you must be able to produce information to the inspection body as stipulated in “Inspection guidelines on building components approved for drinking water”, Annex A.

Every year you must submit the report on the annual inspection prepared by the inspection body, to the Secretariat, cf. section 14 of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013, and in accordance with your agreement with the inspection body pursuant to section 12 of the Executive Order.

The annual inspection must be conducted less than 12 months, respectively 24 months and 36 months after the date of approval.

The annual inspection report must be delivered to the Secretariat no later than 11 months after the approval date. The date for the reception of the inspection report will also be the deadline the following years of the approval period. Later delivery will not be considered in time for maintaining the approval.

If the Secretariat – in connection with the annual inspection – requires additional documentation pursuant to section 13, subsection 3, article 3 and 4, of the Executive Order 2013 you must give the inspection body access to conduct this control.

During the entire approval period the approved building component must continuously meet the relevant product requirements in accordance with the approval. The Secretariat must be notified on conditions that may influence the compliance of the building component with the requirements of the Executive Order, cf. section 17, subsection 1, 1st sentence.

Guidance on withdrawal, etc.

The Secretariat must notify you if the approval is withdrawn, has lapsed or is to be revised, cf. section 17, subsection 1, 2nd sentence, and subsection 2, of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013. This may be the case,

- if supplementary provisions are stipulated, or if provisions are amended or repealed in the relevant area,
- if the approved building component is changed and if this change influences the conditions covered by the approval,
- if, in connection with the inspection carried out, or in some other way, it becomes evident that the approved building component no longer complies with the requirements stipulated,
- if the use of the approved building component has unacceptable impacts on the building components or its surroundings,
- if the approval holder does not meet the conditions stipulated for maintaining the approval, e.g. fails to complete the required own-control,
- if the inspection report on completed inspections is not submitted, or
- if the inspection body has notified the Secretariat that the provisions of your inspection agreement have not been met.

Please be particularly aware to submit the annual inspection report immediately after receipt of the report from the inspection body according to the agreement with the inspection body. If the Secretariat does not receive the inspection report in time, the approval may be withdrawn, and a full fee must be paid for the withdrawal. At the same time the approval of the building component approved for drinking water will be removed from the Secretariat's website.

Guidance on renewal

The approval can be renewed for a new period, if the approval holder before expiry of the valid period submits documentation that the building component still meets the requirements for approval, cf. section 18 (2) of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013. Please be aware that the renewal may imply that the building component must meet new requirements, if the requirements of the Executive Order have been amended during the intervening period.


Appeal instruction

Decisions made by the Secretariat may be appealed to the Danish Energy Agency, cf. section 21 of Executive Order No. 31 of 21 January 2013 on issue of approvals for building components that come into contact with drinking water.

Appeals must be submitted to the Secretariat for building components approved for drinking water by email to: kontakt@godkendtildrikkevand.dk.

Subsequently the Secretariat will evaluate the appeal and will inform you whether the appeal gives rise to any changes of the decision. If the decision is not changed in your favour, the Secretariat will forward the appeal to the appeal authority, the Danish Energy Agency.
